



Dreamy Décor Throw

No matter what your decorating style, this knit throw will add the perfect touch of texture and style. The ideal gift throw, it can be used in a bedroom or living area.

Throw measures 46" x 58".

RED HEART® "Light & Lofty®": 7 skeins 9316 Puff.

Circular Knitting Needles: 10mm [US 15] 36" long.
Cable needle, yarn needle.

GAUGE: 8 sts = 4"; 12 rows = 4" in St st. **CHECK YOUR GAUGE. Use any size needles to obtain the gauge.**

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

Skp = Slip 1, k1, pass slipped stitch over and off needle.

4/4 LC = Slip 4 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k4, k4 from cable needle.

NOTE

Throw is worked back and forth in rows. Circular needles are used to accommodate large number of stitches.

Seed st (worked over an odd number of sts).

Row 1: K1, * p1, k1; repeat from * to end of row.
Repeat Row 1 for Seed st.

THROW

Cast on 93 sts.

Bottom Border

Work 4 rows in Seed st.

Next Row (Inc): K1, p6, * k1, p into front and back of next st, [p1, p into front and back of next st] 2 times, k1, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts; p1, k1–114 sts.

Begin Cable and Lace Pattern

Row 1 (Right Side): K1, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, * p1, k8, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Row 2 and all wrong side rows: K1, p6, * k1, p8, k1, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts; p1, k1.

Row 3: Repeat Row 1.

Row 5: K1, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp, * p1, 4/4 LC, p1, k2tog, yo, k1, yo, skp; repeat from * to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rows 7, 9 and 11: Repeat Row 1.

Row 12: Same as Row 2.

Repeat Rows 1 - 12 twelve times more, or until throw measures 53" from beginning, then repeat Rows 1 - 9 once more.

Next Row (Dec): K1, p6, * k1, p2tog, [p1, p2tog] 2 times, k1, p5; repeat from * to last 2 sts; p1, k1–93 sts.

Top Border: Work 4 rows in Seed st.

Bind off in pattern. Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS: **Dec** = decrease; **inc** = increase; **k** = knit; **mm** = millimeters; **p** = purl; **st(s)** = stitch(es); **St st** = Stockinette stitch; **tog** = together; **yo** = yarn over; **[]** = work directions in brackets the number of times specified; *** or **** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated.



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
