



Crocheted Blue Heaven Wrap

Skill Level



Finished wrap measures approximately 22" wide and 66" long.

Materials

Yarn: Premier Yarns **Big Ball** (100% acrylic; 16 ounces; 1093 yards)

- #29-117 Really Royal – 1 ball

Crochet Hook: US I-9 (5.5 mm) **or size to obtain gauge**

Extras: Yarn needle

Gauge

1 patt rep (17 sts) = 4½"; 1 patt rep (4 rows) = 2½". **Use any size crochet hook to obtain specified gauge.**

Abbreviations

beg – beginning; **ch** – chain; **dc** – double crochet; **lp(s)** – loop(s); **mm** – millimeter; **patt** – pattern; **rep** – repeat; **RS** – right side; **sc** – single crochet; **sk** – skip; **sl st** – slip stitch; **sp(s)** – space(s); **st(s)** – stitch(es); **tr** – treble crochet; **WS** – wrong side; **yo** – yarn over; **[]** – rep instructions inside brackets the number of times specified; ***** – repeat instructions after asterisk as specified.



SPECIAL TERMS:

Shell: (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) all worked in indicated st or sp.

Shell in Shell: Sk 2 dc, work Shell in ch-2 sp, sk next 2 dc.

Dc2tog (Double crochet 2 sts together): Worked over 2 dc. [Yo, insert hook in next dc, yo and pull up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook] twice, yo and draw through 3 lps on hook.

Dc3tog (Double crochet 3 sts together): Worked over 3 dc. [Yo, insert hook in next dc, yo and pull up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps] 3 times, yo and draw through 4 lps on hook.

Tr4tog (Treble crochet 4 sts together): * Yo twice, insert hook in next tr, yo and pull up a lp, [yo and pull through 2 lps on hook] twice; rep from * 3 more times, yo, pull through all 5 lps on hook.

Tr5tog (Treble crochet 5 sts together): * Yo twice, insert hook in next tr, yo and pull up a lp, [yo and pull through 2 lps on hook] twice; rep from * 4 more times, yo, pull through all 6 lps on hook.

SHAWL/WRAP

Ch 76.

Row 1 (WS): Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across, turn – 75 sc.

Row 2 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), sk 2 sts, Shell in next st, [ch 4, sk 7 sts, 3 dc in next st, ch 3, 3 dc in next st, sk 7 sts, Shell in next st] 4 times, sk 2 sts, dc in last st, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, [Shell in Shell, ch 2, 2 dc in next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2, dc in ch-3 sp, ch 2, 2 dc in

next dc, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, ch 2] 4 times, Shell in Shell, dc in last st, turn.

Row 4: Ch 3, [Shell in Shell, ch 2, dc2tog, dc in next dc, dc2tog, ch 3, 3 dc in next dc, ch 3, dc2tog, dc in next dc, dc2tog, ch 2] 4 times, Shell in Shell, dc in last st, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, [Shell in Shell, ch 1, dc3tog, ch 5, dc3tog, ch 5, dc3tog, ch 1] 4 times, Shell in Shell, dc in last st, turn.

Row 6: Ch 3, [Shell in Shell, ch 4, 3 dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, 3 dc in next ch-5 sp, ch 4] 4 times, Shell in Shell, dc in last st, turn.

Rows 7-9: Rep Rows 3-5.

Rep Rows 6-9 23 more times.

Last Row (RS): Ch 1, sc in first dc, [sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in ch-1 sp, 5 sc in each of next 2 ch-5 sps, sc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, sc in each of next 2 dc, sc in ch-2 sp, sc in each of next 3 dc – 75 sc. Fasten off.

BORDER

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in first sc of any short side.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *(sc, ch 6, sc) in first sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, [ch 7, sk 5 sc, sc in each of next 9 sc] 4 times, ch 7, sk 5 sc, sc in each of next 6 sc, (sc, ch 6, sc) in last sc. Working in ends of rows across long side, work 2 sc in each of next 5 rows, [ch 9, sk next 3 rows, 2 sc in each of next 5 rows] 12 times; rep from * once, join with sl st in beg sc.

Rnd 2: Sl st in ch-6 corner sp, (ch 4, 4 tr, ch 5, 5 tr) in same corner sp, ch 6, *(5 tr, ch 5, 5 tr) in next ch-7 sp, ch 6; rep from * to end of rnd, join with a sl st in top of beg ch-4.

Rnd 3: Ch 4, tr4tog, *ch 7, sc in next ch-5 sp, ch 7, tr5tog, ch 7, tr5tog; rep from * to end of rnd, omitting tr5tog at end of last rep, join with a sl st in top of tr4tog.

Rnd 4: Sl st 4 to center of ch-7 lp, ch 1, sc in same sp, ch 8, *sc in next ch-7 lp, ch 8; rep from * to end of rnd, join with a sl st in beg sc; fasten off.

Finishing

Weave in ends.
