



A quick knit to brighten up your Thanksgiving table!

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 1.75"

Height: 2.5"

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville Everyday Soft Worsted
(100% Acrylic; 4 oz / 203 yds)

- ED 100:28 Mustard – 1 ball
- ED 100:25 Scarlet – 1 ball

Needles: US Size 5 (3.75 mm) ndls **or size to obtain gauge**

Notions: tapestry ndl, polyfill or cotton for stuffing, crochet hook

GAUGE

9.5 sts x 13 rows = 4 in patt st

Save time, check your gauge.

ACORN

Using Color A Cast on 4 sts.

Row 1: *K1, m1, rep from * to end of row. (8sts) **Row 2:** Purl all sts **Row 3:** *K1, m1, rep from * to end of row. (16sts) **Row 4:** Purl all sts. **Row 5:** *K2, m1, rep from * to end of row (24sts) **Row 6:** Purl all sts **Row 7:** Knit all sts **Row 8:** Purl all sts **Row 9:** Knit all sts **Row 10:** Purl all sts **Row 11:** Change to color B, knit all sts **Row 12:** Purl all sts **Row 13:** *P1, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. (16 sts) **Row 14, 16, 18:** *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row. **Row 15, 17, 19:** *P1, k1, rep from * to end of row. **Row 20:** *P2tog, k2tog, rep from * to end of row. (8sts) **Row 21:** *K1, p1, rep from * to end of row. **Row 22:** *P1, k1, rep from * to end of row. **Row 23:** * K2tog, p2tog, rep from * to end of row (4 sts)

FINISHING

Draw thread through stitches and pull closed tightly. Seam closed, stuffing with batting as you go. Work ends into acorn and clip remainders.

If desired, crochet a short 'stem' with remaining yarn at top of acorn before clipping. To use as napkin ring, cast on 4 stitches and knit stockinette stitch to desired circumference, bind off and stitch ends together forming a ring. Attach acorn over seam to hide stitching.
