



SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X)
Shown in Small Size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Waist: 26 (28, 32, 36, 40)"
Length: 13½ (14, 14½, 15, 15½)"

MATERIALS

Premier Yarns® Starbella Stripes (100% acrylic; 100g/33 yds)

- 17-13 On Edge – 5 (5, 6, 6, 7) skeins

Needles: US Size 10½ (6.5 mm) 24" circular *or size needed to obtain gauge*

US Size 7 (4.5 mm) 24" circular needle

Notions: Tapestry needle, sewing needle and thread

GAUGE

9 sts x 14 rows = 4" in St st using yarn held closed like a tape

Save time, check your gauge.

Directions:

PATTERN NOTES

When knitting with Starbella in the round, the ruffles show up on the opposite side of the work. The skirt is worked from the wrong side, so that when it is turned inside-out, the ruffles will show on the front.

SKIRT

Waistband

With larger needles and Starbella held closed like a tape, cast on 54 (64, 72, 82, 90,) sts. PM and join to work in the rnd being careful not to twist sts.

Rnd 1: * K1, p1; rep from * to end. Rep this rnd, 5 more times.

Rnd 2: With smaller needles, [kfb] in each st around – 108 (128, 144, 164, 180,) sts.

Skirt Body

Begin working with Starbella as a ruffle yarn, working through the holes in the mesh portion of the yarn.

Rnd 1: Knit.

Rep Rnd 1 until Skirt meas 14 (14½, 15, 15½, 16)'' from cast-on edge to bottom of ruffle. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. If desired, sew down raw edges of Starbella for a neater appearance.

k	knit
kfb	knit in front and back of stitch – 1 stitch increased
meas	measures
PM	place marker
rnd	round
st(s)	stitch(es)
