One Size- Adult

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Length: 64"

Width: 16"

MATERIALS

Deborah Norville Collection™ Serenity Garden by Premier® Yarns (100% dralon microfiber; 65 g/185 yds)

- #800-03 Hibiscus – 7 balls

Hook: US Size G-6(4 mm) crochet hook *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

3 Fans and 3 dcs x 7 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

Pattern Notes

Shawl is crocheted from the Center out by first working the Foundation Chain and crocheting 32" in patt to one end. Yarn is fastened off and reattached to opposite side of beg Foundation ch and crocheted in the opposite direction.

STITCH GUIDE

V- Stitch (V-st)

(Dc, ch 3, dc) in same st or sp

Fan (Fan)

7 dc in the same st or sp

SHAWL

Foundation Chain

Ch 124.

Side 1

Row 1: Dc in 5th ch from hk (counts as dc, ch 1), ch 1, sk 3 ch, dc in next 3 ch, *ch 1, sk 3 ch, V-st in next ch,

ch 1, sk 3 chs, dc in next 3 chs; rep from * across to last 4 chs, ch 1, sk 3 chs, (dc, ch 1, dc) in last ch, turn.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc now and throughout), 3 dc in 1st ch-1 sp, ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, *Fan in next ch-3 sp, ch 1, sk next 2 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1; rep from * ending with 4 dc in last sp, turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, dc in 2nd dc, ch 1, *sk 2 dc, V-st in next dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1; rep from * until 4 dc rem, sk 2 dc, dc in last 2 dc, turn.

Row 4: Ch 4, Fan in ch-3 sp of next V-st, * ch 1, sk 1 dc, dc in next dc, ch 1, Fan in ch-3 sp; rep from * until 1 V-st rem, Fan in ch-3 sp, ch 1, dc in top of beg ch-3, turn.

Row 5: Ch 4, dc in same st, *ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in next 3 dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, V-st in next dc; rep from * until one Fan remains, ch 1, sk 2 dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, ch 1, sk 2 dc, (dc, ch 1, dc) in 3rd ch of beg ch-4, turn.

Rep Rows 2 – 5 for patt until Shawl meas 32" from beg ending with Row 2 of patt.

Fasten off.

Side 2

Attach yarn to opposite side of Foundation Chain, beg working Row 2 of patt. Rep directions for Side 1.

Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block lightly to open lace.
