

Scrappy Table Runner

FINISHED SIZE: Approximately 18¾" x 40½"

MATERIALS REQUIRED:

- Trace 'n Create Tumbler Template
- ⅝ yd. Fabric A
- ¼ yd. Fabric B
- ¼ yd. Fabric C
- ¼ yd. Fabric D
- ¼ yd. Fabric E
- ½ yd. Binding
- ⅝ yd. Backing
- ⅝ yd. Batting



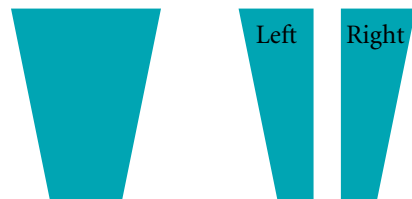

MAKING THE TABLE RUNNER:

Note: Use ¼" seams.

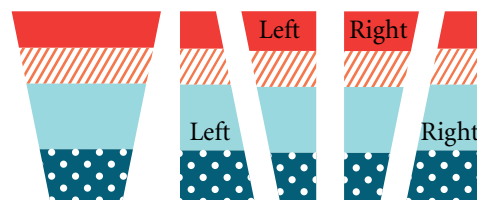
1. Cut fabrics.

- Fabric A: Cut two 8½" crosswise strips.
 - Using the Trace 'n Create Tumbler Template, trace and subcut 8 Tumblers and 4 Finishing Pieces following instructions included with the template.
 - To make a left Finishing Piece place the template right side up. To make a right Finishing Piece, flip over the template so it is right side down.

- Fabrics B, C, D, and E:
 - Prepare a strata by cutting crosswise strips of various widths from Fabrics B, C, D, and E and joining strips to make two 8½" strata.
 - Trace and subcut 7 Scrappy Tumblers and 6 Scrappy Finishing Pieces.

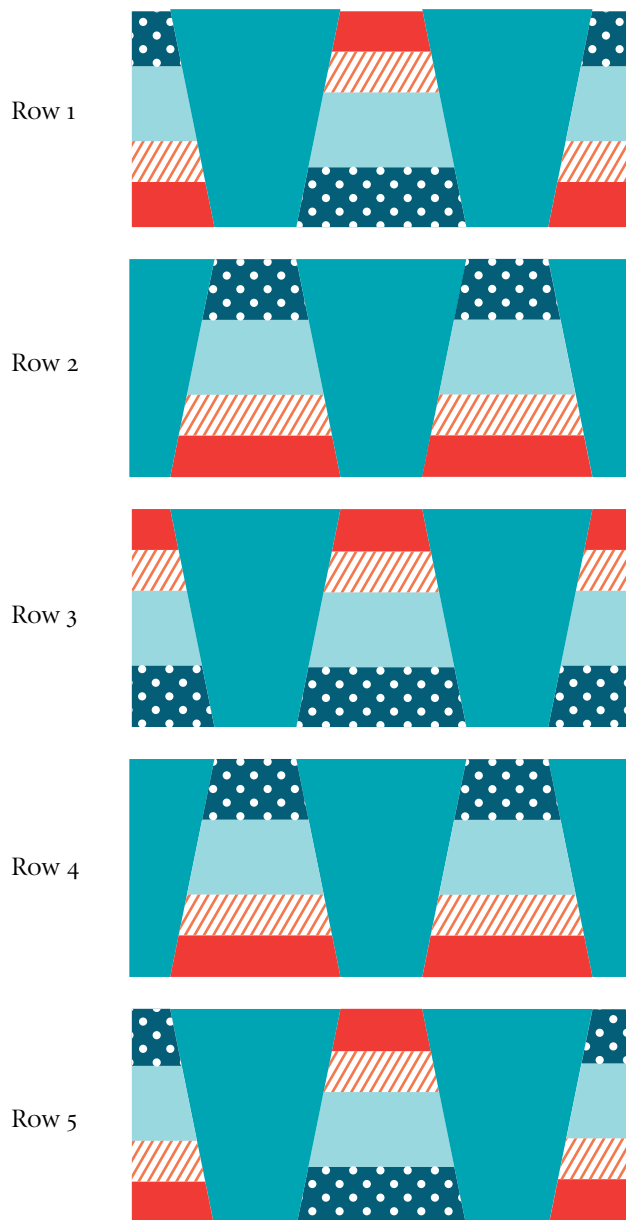
- Binding: Cut four 2½" crosswise strips.



2. Construct the table runner.

- Refer to layout guide below. Arrange plain and scrappy tumblers and finishing pieces in five horizontal rows as shown in layout.
- Join tumblers and finishing pieces in each of the five horizontal rows, right sides together. Press seams open.
- Join Row 1 to Row 2, right sides together. Press seam open.
- Repeat until all five rows are joined together. Press.
- Square the table runner. For additional information on squaring and layering, accenting with machine quilting, and binding quilts, refer to *How to Finish Quilts Guide Set*, Item # FQGST, available from Nancy's Notions.
- Layer the table runner.
 - Place the backing on a smooth, flat surface, wrong side up. Tape edges in place.
 - Center the batting over the backing.
 - Center the table runner top over the batting.
 - Pin layers together using Curved Basting Pins, size 1.
- Quilt the table runner using your favorite method.
- Trim excess batting and backing. Machine baste a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " from outer edges.
- Bind the table runner using your favorite method.
