YARN Peruvian Connection Alpaca Handpaints – 2 skeins

NEEDLES Size 10 ½ needles

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS Approximately 5¾" wide x 55" long.

INSTRUCTIONS (These instructions are for those wishing to knit the scarf in one piece, rather than 2 halves joined in the middle as shown in the Advanced Instructions.) With size 10 ½ needles cast on 21 stitches. Knit 6 rows garter stitch (knit every row). On next row (RS), begin the undulating stitch pattern beginning on row 1. Work even until the scarf measures about 54" long – ending on row 20. Knit 6 more rows in garter stitch. Bind off all stitches loosely.

ADVANCED INSTRUCTIONS (These instructions are for the more advanced knitter. The scarf shown was knit in two halves and joined at the middle so that the leaves are going in the same direction when wrapped around the neck.) Cast on and begin knitting the pattern according to the basic instructions. Continue with the undulating leaves pattern until the piece measures approximately 27" to 27½" or until one ball of yarn is almost finished. End with row 20(VS). Put all stitches on a stitch holder. With the second ball of yarn, knit another half scarf in exactly the same way, except end with row 19 (RS). Once you have both halves completed, put the first half back on a needle, leave the second half on a needle. Hold the two halves together with rights sides facing each other and with a third needle, bind off both pieces together.

FINISHING Weave in all loose ends and trim the tails.

UNDULATING LEAVES STITCH PATTERN (rows 1 - 20)

Row 1: K4, P2, C2B, P2 K1B, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 2 (AND ALL EVEN ROWS): K4, Knit stitches as established in previous row UNTIL 4 STS REM, K4

Row 3: K4, P2, C2B, P2, M3, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 5: K4, P2, C2B, P2, K1, YO, K1, YO, K1, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 7: K4, P2, C2B, P2, K2 YO, K1, YO, K2, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 9: K4, P2, C2B, P2, K3, YO, K1, YO, K3, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 11: K4, P2, C2B, P2, K2, SL1, K1, PSSO, YO, K1, YO, K2 TOG, K2, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 13: K4, P2, C2B, P2, SL1 (KNITWISE), K1, PSSO, K5, K2 TOG, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 15: K4, P2, C2B, P2, SL1 (KNITWISE), K1, PSSO, K3, K2 TOG, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 17: K4, P2, C2B, P2, SL1 (KNITWISE), K1, PSSO, K1, K2 TOG, P2, C2B, P2, K4

Row 19: K4, P2, C2B, P2, SL1 (KNITWISE), K2 TOG, PSSO, P2, C2B, P2, K4
