

# basic beanie hat

## Skill Level

Easy


## Finished Sizes

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

Brim circumference:

18 (20, 22)" [46 (51, 56)cm]

## Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Attire Worsted (100% extra fine merino; 50g/110yds) -731819-0007  Terra-Cotta (2 balls)
- US size 7 (4.5mm) set of dpn or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle
- Stitch markers

## Gauge

20 sts x 24 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

in St st

*Save time, check your gauge.*



## Instructions

CO 90 (102, 114) sts. Divide sts evenly among dpn, pm, and join to work in the rnd.

Work in St st (k every rnd) until hat measures 7 (7½, 8)" [17.8 (19.1, 20.3)cm] from CO edge.

## Shape Crown

**Setup Rnd:** \*K15 (17, 19), pm; rep from \* to end.

**Dec Rnd:** \*Ssk, k to 2 sts before m, k2tog, sl m; rep from \* to end—12 sts dec'd.

**Next Rnd:** K.

Rep last 2 rnds until 30 sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** [K2tog] across rnd—15 sts rem.

**Next Rnd:** [K2tog] to last 3 sts, k3tog—7 sts rem.

Break yarn, thread through yarn needle, and pass through rem live sts. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

## PROJECT TIP

### Care Guide for Handmade Gifts

*When you give a knit or crochet item as a gift, include a small tag, label, or note with care instructions that are specific to the yarn from which it was made. This will save the recipient from having to guess how to clean or care for the item and avoid potential damage due to incorrect laundering.*
