Finished Size

28" x 6" (71cm x 15.2cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Ripples 
(63% combed cotton/
35% nylon; 50g/110yds)
-732107-0007
Primary (1 ball): A
-732107-0008
Bangles (1 ball): B
- US size 5 (3.75mm) 24"
circular needle or size
needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch marker
- Yarn needle

Gauge

20 sts x 24 rows = 4"
(10.2cm) in Slip Stitch Pattern
Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

Slip Stitch Pattern

Rnd 1-2: K.

Rnd 3: *K1, sl 1, rep from *.

Rep Rnds 1-3 for pat.

Instructions

Cowl

With A, CO 140 sts. Join for working in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts. Pm to indicate start of rnd. P 3 rnds.

Begin Pattern

Rnds 1-2: K.

Rnd 3: With B, *K1, sl 1 p-wise wyib; rep from * to end.

Rnds 4-5: K.

Rnd 6: With A, *K1, sl 1 p-wise wyib; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnds 1-6 six more times.

With B, P 3 rnds. BO all sts loosely.

Weave in ends.



PROJECT TIP

Care Guide for Handmade Gifts

When you give a knit or crochet item as a gift, include a small tag, label, or note with care instructions that are specific to the yarn from which it was made. This will save the recipient from having to guess how to clean or care for the item and avoid potential damage due to incorrect laundering.
