

tiny tot hat & booties

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Size

Infant (6-12 mos)

Finished Measurements

Hat circumference: 18½" (47cm)

Length of booties: 4" (10.2cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Fawn DK 3
(50% bamboo/50% acrylic;
1.75 oz/50g/132yd)
-731283-0003 Pattycake (2 balls)
- US size F-5 (3.75mm) crochet hook
or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

16 dc x 9 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

dc2tog: (Yo and draw up a lp in next st, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook) twice, yo and draw through all lps on hook

cluster: (Yo and draw up a lp, yo and draw through 2 lps on hook) 3 times in next dc, yo and draw through all lps on hook

sc2tog (single crochet 2 together): Insert hook into st and draw up a lp, insert hook into next st and draw up a lp, yo and draw through all 3 lps on hook.

Sliding lp: Make a lp, leaving a short tail. Reach through the lp with hook and draw through the yarn. Work Rnd 1 of pat. Gently pull tail to close lp.



Instructions

Booties

Ch 14.

Sole

Rnd 1 (RS): Dc in fourth ch from hook, dc in each of next 9 chs, 5 dc in last ch, working into rem lp on opposite side of ch, dc in each of next 9 chs, 3 dc in last ch; join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same sp as last sl st, 2 dc in next dc, dc in each of

next 9 dc, 2 dc in each of next 5 dc, dc in each of next 9 dc, 2 dc in each of last 3 dc; join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Upper Sole

Rnd 1: Ch 1, working in back lp only of each st, sc in same sp as last sl st, sc in each of next 12 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, dc in each of next 4 sts, hdc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 15 sts; join with sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, dc in same sp as last sl st, dc in each of next 15 sts, (dc2tog) twice,

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dc in each of next 17 sts, 2 dc in last st; join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in each of next 16 sts, (dc2tog) twice, dc in each of last 18 sts; join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, sc in same sp as last sl st, sc in each of next 11 sts, hdc in each of next 2 sts, (dc2tog) 4 times, hdc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of next 11 sts, sc2tog over last 2 sts; join with sl st to first sc—32 sts.

Rnd 5 (eyelets): Ch 4, sk first 2 sts, *dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around. Join with sl st to third ch of ch 4.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in same sp as last sl st, *ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, cluster, ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc; rep from * around, ending with ch 2, sk last ch-1 sp, sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

Ties (make 2)

Make a ch 12" (30cm) long. Fasten off. Weave ties through eyelet rnd and tie.

Hat

Beg with sliding lp.

Rnd 1: Ch 3, work 15 dc into lp; join with sl st to top of ch 3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—24 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, dc in next dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—32 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, dc in next 2 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—40 dc.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, dc in next 3 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in

next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—48 dc.

Rnd 6: Ch 3, dc in next 4 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—56 dc.

Rnd 7: Ch 3, dc in next 5 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—64 dc.

Rnd 8: Ch 3, dc in next 6 dc, 2 dc in next dc, (dc in next 7 dc, 2 dc in next dc) to end; join with sl st to first dc—72 dc.

Rnd 9: Ch 3, dc in each dc to end; join with sl st to first dc—72 dc. Rep Rnd 9 until hat measures 6" (15.2cm) from beg.

Next Rnd (eyelets): Ch 4, sk first 2 sts, *dc in next st, ch 1, sk next st; rep from * around. Join with sl st to third ch of ch 4.

Next Rnd: Ch 1, sc in same sp as last sl st, *ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, cluster, ch 2, sk next ch-1 sp, sc in next dc; rep from * around, ending with ch 2, sk last ch-1 sp, sl st in first sc. Fasten off.

PROJECT TIP

Care Guide for Handmade Gifts

When you give a knit or crochet item as a gift, include a small tag, label, or note with care instructions that are specific to the yarn from which it was made. This will save the recipient from having to guess how to clean or care for the item and avoid potential damage due to incorrect laundering.

Tie

Make a ch 30" (76cm) long. Fasten off. Weave tie through eyelet rnd and tie.
