Welcome Tooth Fairy Pillow

Easy

Finished Size

7½" x 9½" (19.1cm x 24.1cm)

Materials

4

- Willow Yarns™ Fawn Worsted (50% rayon from bamboo/50% acrylic; 50g/99yd)
 - 731281-0001 White (1 ball): A
 - 731281-0014 Candy Apple (1 ball): B
 - 731281-0012 Teddy Bear (1 ball): C
- US size 8 (5mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- US Size 7 (4.5mm) dpn
- Two ½" (1.3cm) buttons of choice
- Fiberfill
- Yarn needle
- Sewing needle
- White sewing thread

Gauge

17 sts x 26 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st

Stitch Guide

i-cord: With dpn, CO the number of sts required in pat, *k across, then slide the sts to the other end of the needle (the left side of the left needle); rep from *until you have reached the required length.

St st:

K 1 row.

P 1 row.

Rep these 2 rows the number of rows indicated in pat.

Pattern Note

- Front/Back of pat starts working 2 separate sections at the same time. These sections are joined together in Row 3 and worked as one complete row through Row 36. In Row 37, the row is split again, worked in 2 separate sections through Row 58.

Instructions

Pillow (make 2)

With A and size 8 needles, working from the outside of the ball, CO 11 sts. Working from the inside of the ball, CO 11 sts (you will have 2 sections).

Row 1 (WS): Working with each section separately, p across both sections.

Row 2: [(K3, kfb) twice, K3] across each section (26 sts).

Row 3: Using 1 strand of yarn, p across both sections to make one piece.

Row 4: K1, (k5, kfb) 4 times, k1.

Row 5: P across.

Row 6: K1, (k6, kfb) 4 times, k1 across.

Row 7: Rep Row 5.

Rows 8-31: Work in St st, ending on WS row.

Row 32: K1, (k6, k2tog) 4 times, k1.

Row 33: Rep Row 5.

Row 34: K1, (k12, k2tog) twice, k1.

Row 35: Rep Row 5.

Row 36: K13, BO 2, k13.

Row 37: Working from inside and outside of yarn to make 2 sections, rep Row 1.

Note: Cont working in 2 sections through rest of Front/Back.

Row 38: On first section, k12, BO 1. On second section, BO 1, K12.

Row 39: Rep Row 1.

Row 40: On first section, k11, BO 1. On second section, BO 1, K11.

Rows 41-49: Work in St st across each section, ending on a WS row.

Row 50 (RS): [(K3, k2tog) twice, k1] across each section.

Row 51: Rep Row 1.

Row 52: [K1, (k2tog, k2) twice] across each section.

Row 53: Rep Row 1.

Row 54: [(K1, k2tog) twice, k1] across each section.

Row 55: Rep Row 1.

Row 56: [K1, (k2tog) twice] across each section.

Row 57: Rep Row 1.

Row 58: BO across each section.

PROJECT TIP

Organize Your Supplies

Knitting and crocheting is easier and more enjoyable when your supplies are accessible and organized. Try keeping a notebook of information on the yarn in your stash, including brand, color name or number, weight, care instructions, and amount that you have left. Update the list regularly so you always know what you have on hand. Also, keep your needles and hooks organized by size so they are easy to access for each project.

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Joining Front to Back

Block both Front and Back, shaping tooth before stitching tog.

With A and WS tog, starting at the top left side, stitch both sides tog with a running stitch, leaving a 3" (7.6cm) opening on the side for stuffing pillow. Stuff pillow but not tightly, sewing opening closed.

Money Flap

With A, CO 15 sts.

Row 1: P across.

Row 2: K across.

Next Row: Work in St st for 13 more rows, ending with a WS row.

Buttonhole Row: K2, BO 2, k across to last 4 sts, BO 2, k2.

Next Row: P2, CO 2 sts, p next 7 sts, CO 2, p2.

Next Row: BO all sts across.

I-Cord Hanger

With A and size 7 dpn, CO 4 sts.

Work i-cord for approx 10" (25cm). BO and weave in ends. Using picture as guide, attach hanger on the left and right side at the top of the tooth.

Bow

With B and size 7 dpn, CO 8 sts.

Work i-cord for approx 3½" (8.9cm). BO and weave in ends. Wrap 1 strand of B around center of bow 10 times, tie a small knot on back side, weave in ends. Using picture as guide attach as bow or bow tie as you wish.

Finishing

Eyes:

With C and using the picture as a guide, backstitch the eyes in place.

Mouth:

With B and using the picture as a guide, backstitch the mouth.

Money Flap:

With A and centering on the back of the tooth, stitch 1" (2.5cm) from the bottom of flap down the left side, stitch along the bottom and stitch 1" (2.5cm) up the right side. Fasten off. Using floss and sewing needle, line up buttons with buttonhole and st in place on the back of the tooth.

Weave in any ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately

BO: bind off

cm: centimeter

CO: cast on

cont: continue

dpn: double pointed needles:

k: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

kfb: knit front and back of stitch—an increase is made

p: purl

pat: pattern

rep: repeat

RS: right side

st/sts: stitch/stitches

St st: Stockinette stitch

tog: together

WS: wrong side
