Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Wash Worsted (100% anti-pill acrylic; 100g/180yd)
-732142-0024 Snow (2 balls): A
-732142-0005 Little Flower (2 balls): B
-732142-0021 Granite (2 balls): C
- US size G-6 (4mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

2¼ shells x 14 rows = 4"
(10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge

Stitch Guide

shell: 7 tr in next st.

Pattern Note

- Join all yarn with the RS facing, doing so you can carry the yarn through the blanket. Adding the border will help cover up the yarn being carried up.

Instructions

With A, ch 130.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch from hook and in each ch across—129 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across.

Row 3: With B, ch 1, sc in first sc, sk next 3 sc, shell in next sc, *ch 1, sk 7 sc, shell in next sc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sk next 3 sc, sc in last st.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, sc in next 7 tr, *sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next 7 tr; rep from * across to last sc, sc in last sc.

Row 5: With A, ch 1, sc in first sc, *sc in next 7 sc, sc bet shells into the fourth sc from the third sc row below (sc this sc loosely); rep from * to last sc, sc in last sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across.

Row 7: Join C with sl st in first sc, ch 4, 3 tr in same sc, *ch 1, sk 7 sc, shell in next st; rep from * to last 8 sts, sk 7 sc, 4 tr in last sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in next 4 tr, *sc in ch-1 sp, sc in next 7 tr; rep from * to last 4 tr, sc in last 4 tr.

Row 9: With A, ch 1, sc in next 4 sc, *sc bet shells into the fourth sc from the third sc row below (sc this sc loosely), sc in next 7 sc; rep from * to last 4 sc, sc in last 4 sc.

Row 10: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Rep Rows 3-10 fifteen more times or until work from beg is approx 36" (91cm).

ABBREVIATIONS

approx: approximately

beg: begin/beginning

bet: between

ch/chs: chain/chains

cm: centimeter

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

sk: skip

sl st: slip stitch

sp: space

st/sts: stitch/stitches

tr: treble crochet

Border

Join C, with sc in top left corner st, 3 sc in corner, *3 sc around C tr, sc at the end of next 5 rows; rep from * to next corner. 3 sc in next corner, sc in each of the ch sts to next corner, 3 sc in next corner, **sc at end of next 5 rows, 3 sc around C tr; rep from ** to next corner. 3 sc in next corner, sc in each sc across the top; join with sl st to first sc. Weave in all ends.
