Stars & Stripes Table Runner

Easy

Finished Size

12" x 42" (30cm x 107cm)

Materials

- Willow Yarns™ Wash Worsted (100% anti-pill acrylic; 100g/169yd)
-732142-0002 Cranberry (1 ball): A
-732142-0023 Cream (1 ball): B
-732142-0033 Catalina Blue (2 balls): C
- US size I-9 (5.5mm) hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

15 sts x 12 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge

Stitch Guide

puff st: (Yo, insert hook in st, yo, pull up lp) 3 times, yo and pull through all 7 lps on hook.

rsc (reverse sc): Working backwards, *insert hook in previous sc, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook; rep from * around.

Pattern Notes

- Changing color in sc, insert hook in next st, yo, drop working yarn, pick up next color and pull through 2 lps on hook.
- Changing color at the end of puff st, work puff st to right before pulling through all lps on hook, drop working color, pick up next color and pull through all 7 lps on hook.
- When working the stars, only carry B through on that row, sc over B when not working puff st, cut B at the end of row.

Instructions

First Side

With A, ch 105.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch from hook, hdc in next st, *sc in next st, hdc in next st; rep from * across row, turn—104 sts.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in first st, hdc in next st, *sc in next st, hdc in next st; rep from * across row, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: Rep Row 2, changing to B in last st on Row 3, ch 1, turn.

Rows 4-6: Rep Row 2, changing to A at the end of Row 6, ch 1, turn.

Rows 7-9: Rep Row 2, changing to B at the end of the Row 9, ch 1, turn.

Rows 10-12: Rep Row 2, changing to A at the end of Row 12, ch 1, turn.

Rows 13-15: Rep Rows 7-9.

Rep Rows 10-15 four more times. Fasten off A at the end of last row.

Side Borders First Side

With RS facing working on either side of table runner and working at the end of the rows, join C with sc in first row, work 3 more sc in the end rows of this stripe, work 3 sc in each striped section, ch 1, turn—40 sc.

Row 2: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn—40 sc.

Rows 3-4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Sc in 3 sc, changing to B in last sc, puff st in next st, changing to C before pulling through all 7 lps on hook, *sc in next 7 sc, changing to B in last sc, puff st in next st, changing to C before pulling through all 7 lps on hook; rep from * 3 more times. With C, sc in last 4 sc.

Rows 6-8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Rows 10-12: Rep Row 2.

Row 13: Rep Row 5.

Rows 14-16: Rep Row 2.

Row 17: Rep Row 5.

Rows 18-20: Rep Row 2.

Row 21: Rep Row 5.

Rows 22-25: Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

Second Side

With RS facing, join C with sc at the end of row (counts as first sc of row).

Row 1 (RS): Sc in next 3 sts (end of rows), working 3 sc at the end of each stripe, work 40 sc evenly down the side, ch 1, turn.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch: chain

cm: centimeter

hdc: half double crochet

lp/lps: loop/loops

rep: repeat

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

st/sts: stitch/stitches

yo: yarn over

Row 2: Sc in each sc across, ch 1, turn—40 sc.

Rows 3-4: Rep Row 2.

Row 5: Sc in first 4 sc, changing to B in the last sc, puff st in next st, changing to C before pulling through all lps on hook. *With C, sc in next 7 sc, changing to B in last sc, puff st in next st, changing to C before pulling through all lps on hook; rep from * 3 more times. With C, sc in last 3 sc, ch 1, turn.

Rows 6-8: Rep Row 2.

Row 9: Rep Row 5.

Rows 10-12: Rep Row 2.

Row 13: Rep Row 5.

Rows 14-16: Rep Row 2.

Row 17: Rep Row 5.

Rows 18-20: Rep Row 2.

Row 21: Rep Row 5.

Rows 22-25: Rep Row 2. Do not fasten off, do not turn.

Edging

Rsc in second sc from end, *rsc in next 38 sc, 3 rsc in corner st, 24 rsc across the end of blue section, 104 rsc along the striped section, 24 rsc across the end rows of next blue section, 3 rsc in corner st; rep from * once more. Join with sl st to first rsc. Fasten off and weave in any ends.
