Crashing Waves Granny Tote

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Sizes

13" x 14" (33cm x 36cm)

Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Burrow Worsted (75% acrylic/25% washable wool; 100g/197yd)
- 730001-0047 Marine (1 ball): A
- 730001-0060 Woolen (1 ball): B
- 730001-0046 Navy (1 ball): C
- 730001-0038 Steel (1 ball): D
- US size H-8 (5mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

Rnds 1-5 = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge.

Instructions

With A, ch 4, sl st to form a ring.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), 2 dc in ring (ch 2, 3 dc) 3 times, ch 2, sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Rnd 2: Sl st to ch-2 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, *ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from * around, ch 1, sl st to top of beg ch 3. Fasten off A.

Note: Panel is now worked on only two sides of the square.

Rnd 3: Join B in any ch-2 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-2 sp. Turn.

Rnd 4: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), [(3 dc, ch 1) in next ch-1 sp] twice, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, [(3 dc, ch 1) in next ch-1 sp] twice, dc in top of ch-3 from previous row. Turn. Fasten off B.

Rnd 5: Join C to first ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp across, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp across, 3 dc in last ch-1 sp. Turn.

Row 6: Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1), (3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp across, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp across, dc in top of ch 3 from previous row. Turn. Fasten off.

Rnds 7-8: With D, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 9-10: With A, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 11-12: With B, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 13-14: With C, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 15-16: With D, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 17-18: With A, rep Rows 5-6.

Rnds 19-20: With B, rep Rows 5-6.

Note: Panel is now worked around entire square.

Rnd 21: Join C to first ch-1 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, ch 1 *(3 dc, ch 1) in each ch-1 sp across, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * once. **(3 dc, ch 1) in each sp down side of square, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in ch-2 sp; rep from ** once, ch 2, sl st to top of beg ch 3.

Rnd 22: Ch 1, sc in each st around working (sc, ch 1, sc) in each corner sp. Do not fasten off.

Holding both panels so that the striping pat mirror each other and panels are on WS, ch 1, work sc in each st around through both panels to join. Leave one side of panels unworked, as this is your opening for the bag.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin/beginning

ch/chs: chain/chains

cm: centimeter

dc: double crochet

pat: pattern

rep: repeat

rnd/rnds: round/rounds

RS: right side

sc: single crochet

sl st: slip stitch

sk: skip

sp: space

st/sts: stitch/stitches

WS: Wrong Side

Turn bag so that the RS is showing.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, sc in each st around the opening of the tote, sl st to first sc to join—100 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each st around, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc in next 17 sc, ch 16, sk 16 sc, sc in next 17 sc; rep from * once more, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc in next 17 sc, 16 sc in ch-16 sp, sc in next 17 sc; rep from * once more, sl st to first sc to join.

Rnds 5-6: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl to first sc to join. Fasten off after Rnd 6. Weave in all ends.

Finishing

Block if desired.
