Farmhouse Curtains

Skill Level

Easy

Finished Size

Fits window size 36" x 48" (91cm x 122cm)

Each panel: 36" x 24" (91cm x 61cm)

Valance: 72" x 12" (183cm x 30cm)

Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Farmhouse Cotton (100% cotton; 100g/328yd)
-730199-0049 Dusty Rose (3 balls): A
-730199-0025 Magnolia (3 balls): B
-730199-0053 Viridian (2 balls): C
- US size E-4 (3.5mm) crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

2½ chevrons x 9 rows = 4" (10.2cm)

Save time, check your gauge.

Stitch Guide

dc2tog (double crochet 2

together): Yo, insert hook in indicated st, pull up lp, yo, pull through 2 lps, yo, sk dc2tog, insert hook in next st, yo, pull up lp, (yo, pull through 2 lps) 3 times.

Note: Dc2tog on Row 1 is same as above, but you sk 2 chs bet dc.

Changing color: Work st before changing to last 2 lps on hook. Cut current yarn, leaving about 6" (15.2 cm), pick up new color, yo, pull through 2 lps on hook. Color change made.

Pattern Notes

- This pat is very easy to adjust length. Add or delete the rows needed for length desired. Width will stay same.
- Beg ch 2 counts as dc unless otherwise noted.

Rows 2-3: Ch 2, dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc, *(dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc; rep from * ending with 2 dc in last dc. Change to C. Turn.

Rows 4-6: With C, rep Row 2, turn.

Rows 7-11: With A, rep Row 2, turn.

Rows 12-19: With B, rep Row 2, turn.

Rows 20-32: With C, rep Row 2, turn,

Rows 33-50: With A, rep Row 2, turn.

Row 51: Ch 9, dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc, *(dc, ch 9, dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc; rep from *, ending with dc in last dc, ch 9, sl st in top of last dc on previous row. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Valance

Using A, ch 402.

Rows 1-2: Working in bottom bump across, dc in third ch from hook, dc in next 2 dc, *dc2tog (over next 4 chs), 3 dc, ch 2, dc in next 3 chs; rep from * to last 7 chs, dc2tog, dc in next 2 chs, 2 dc in last ch. Change to B. Turn—282 dc.

Rows 3-25: Ch 2, dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc, *(dc, ch 2, dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc; rep from *, ending with 2 dc in last dc. Turn.

Row 26: Ch 9, dc in first dc, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc, *(dc, ch 9, dc) in ch-2 sp, dc in next 2 dc, dc2tog, dc in next 2 dc; rep from *, ending with dc in last dc, ch 9, sl st in last dc of previous row. Fasten off and weave in ends.

Instructions

Panel (make 2)

Using A, ch 202.

Row 1: Working in bottom bump across, dc in third ch from hook (first 2 chs count as

dc), dc in next 2 chs, *dc2tog (worked over 4 chs), dc in next 3 chs, ch 2, dc in next 3 chs; rep from * to last 7 chs, dc2tog, dc in next 2 chs, 2 dc in last ch. Change to B. Turn—142 dc (counting dc2tog as 1 dc)
