Finished Size

72" x 11" (183cm x 28cm)

Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Daily DK (100% superwash wool; 100g/284yd)
-733411-0048 Canna Lily (1 ball): A
-733411-0028 Ice (1 ball): B
-733411-0049 Night Sky (1 ball): C
- US size 6 (4mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 6 (4mm) dpn or size needed to obtain gauge
- Stitch markers

Gauge

20 sts and 40 rows = 4"

(10.2cm) in garter st

Save time, check your gauge.

Instructions

Striped Pennant (make 3)

With A, leaving a long tail, CO 30 sts.

Rows 1-6: (Sl 1, p-wise, wyif), k to end.

Rows 7-8: (Sl 1, p-wise, wyif), k2tog, k to end, cut A.

Rows 9-16: With B, rep Rows 1-8.

Cont to rep Rows 1-16 until 3 sts rem.

Last Row: (Sl 1, p-wise, wyif, k2tog, pssso. Cut yarn. Pull yarn end through last st.

Star Pennant (make 2)

With C, rep stripe pennant using one color.

Star (make 2)

With B, leaving a long tail, CO 2 sts.

Row 1-2: K, turn.

Rows 3-4: Kfb, k to end, turn—4 sts.

Rows 5-8: Rep Rows 1-4—6 sts.

Cut yarn, leave sts on needle.

Rep Rnds 1-8 four more times, making 4 more points. Do not cut yarn after last point. Divide points onto dpn to k in the rnd. K 3 sts. Pm for beg of rnd—30 sts.

Rnd 1: *K2, k2tog, k2; rep from * around—25 sts.

Rnd 2: P.

Rnd 3: *K1, k2tog, k2; rep from * around—20 sts.

Rnd 4: P.

Rnd 5: *K1, k2tog, k1; rep from * around—15 sts.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg: begin/beginning

cm: centimeter

CO: Cast On

cont: continue

dpn: double pointed needles

k: knit

kfb: knit front and back

k2tog: knit 2 together

pm: place marker

pssso: pass slipped stitch over

p-wise: purlwise

rem: remain/remaining

rep: repeat

rnd: round

sl: slip

st/sts: stitch/stitches

wyif: with yarn in front

Rnd 6: P.

Rnd 7: *K2tog, k1; rep from * around—10 sts.

Rnd 8: K2tog around—5 sts.

Cut yarn and pull through rem sts. Fasten off center. Center star onto solid colored pennant and tack each point down using CO tail. Tack center down using ending yarn.

Finishing

Overlap alternating pennants by 1" (2.5cm) and sew in place using CO tails.
