# Bluebell Onesie and Bonnet Set

## Skill Level

Easy

## Finished Size

6 mos

## Materials



- Willow Yarns™ Meadow (100% cotton; 50g/103yd) -731937-0013 Thistle (4 balls)
- US size 7 (4.5mm) straight needles or size needed to obtain gauge
- US size 7 (4.5mm) dpn or size needed to obtain gauge
- Three ½" (2cm) buttons
- Matching thread for sewing on buttons
- Yarn needle

## Gauge

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" (10.2cm) in St st

*Save time, check your gauge.*

## Stitch Guide

**i-cord:** Using 2 dpn, CO 4 sts. \*Slide sts to right end of needle, k4, do not turn, rep from \*.

**backwards lp method:** Hold needle in dominant hand, hold strand about 10" (25cm) from ball, make a slip knot and place on needle, then using yarn from ball, place the yarn over thumb from front to back creating a lp, insert needle in the center of lp and pull the lp snug on needle, rep for desired amount of CO sts.

**garter st:** K every row.

## check pat:

*(multiple 4 + 2)*

**Rows 1 and 3 (RS):** \*K2, p2; rep from \* to last 2 sts, k2.

**Rows 2 and 4:** P2, \*k2, p2; rep from \* to end.

**Rows 5-8:** K.

Rep Rows 1-8 for pat.

## Instructions

### Onesie

#### Back

Starting at bottom, CO 14 sts.

**Rows 1 (RS):** K across.

**Rows 2-8:** Rep Row 1, ending with a WS row.

#### Shape Leg Opening

**Note:** Rows 1-16 are inc rows.

**Row 1 (RS):** CO 2 sts at beg of row and work Row 1 of check pat.

**Rows 2:** CO 2 sts at beg of row, work Row 2 of check pat.

**Rows 3-16:** Rep Row 2, working the correct row of check pat—46 sts at the end of Row 16.

**Next Rows:** Cont working in check pat until the piece measures 8" (20.3cm) from top of leg opening, ending after a WS row.

#### Shape Arm Opening

**Row 1 and All RS Rows (RS):** K4, k2tog, work in check pat to last 6 sts, ssk, k4.

**Row 2 and All WS Rows:** K4, p1, work in check pat to last 5 sts, p1, k4.

Rep these 2 rows 9 times—26 sts.

**Row 21:** K across.

**Rows 22-28:** Rep Row 21.  
BO.

#### Front

Beg at the bottom, CO 14 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K across.

**Rows 2-4:** K across.

**Row 5 (Buttonhole Row):** K2, yo, k2tog, k3, yo, k2tog, k2, yo, k2tog, k1.

**Rows 6-8:** K across.

Cont working the front the same as the Back. Fasten off and weave in ends.

#### Finishing

Sew side seams.

#### Leg Edging

Pick up and k40 along leg edge.

**Rnd 1 (RS):** K around.

**Rnds 2-4:** Rep Rnd 1.

BO loosely.

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## ABBREVIATIONS

**beg:** begin/beginning

**B0:** Bind Off

**cm:** centimeter

**CO:** Cast On

**cont:** continue

**dpn:** double pointed needles

**inc:** increase

**k:** knit

**k2tog:** knit 2 stitches together

**lp:** loop

**p:** purl

**pat:** pattern

**rem:** remain/remaining

**rep:** repeat

**rnd/rnds:** round/rounds

**RS:** Right Side

**sk:** slip, slip, knit these

2 stitches together—

a decrease is made

**st/sts:** stitch/stitches

**St st:** Stockinette stitch

**WS:** Wrong Side

**yo:** yarn over

## I-cord Straps (make 4)

Knit in I-cord for 8" (20.3cm). B0. Sew one i-cord strap to top edge of front and back.

Match buttons to buttonhole openings and sew in place on back.

## Bonnet

CO 82 sts.

**Row 1 (RS):** K across.

**Rows 2-4:** K across.

**Next Rows:** Working 2 sts at each edge in garter st, cont working in check pat for 5½" (14cm), ending after a WS row.

## Shape Back of Bonnet

**Note:** The back of the bonnet is worked in the rnd using dpn.

**Rnd 1:** (K3, k2tog) 16 times, k2—66 sts.

**Rnds 2-6:** K.

**Rnd 7:** (K2, k2tog) 16 times, k2—50 sts.

**Rnds 8-12:** K.

**Rnd 13:** (K1, k2tog) 16 times, k2—34 sts.

**Rnds 14-18:** K.

**Rnd 19:** (K2tog) 16 times, k2—18 sts. Cut yarn, thread through rem sts. Fasten off.

## I-cord Ties (make 2)

Same as I-cord straps for Onesie.
