

# Nako Pop Mix Hat & Cowl



## SIZE

Cowl: About 25" (64cm) around, about 10" (25cm) long  
Hat: 19" (48cm) around

## MATERIALS

**Nako Pop Mix:** 2 balls in color of choice  
Shown in 6596 Blues



## Needles:

- US size 10½ (6.5mm) 16" circular needle or size to obtain gauge
- US size 10½ (6.5mm) double pointed needles or size to obtain gauge
- US size 11 (8mm) 24" circular needle or size to obtain gauge
- US size 13 (9mm) or 15 (10mm) needle for cowl bind off

**Notions:** Stitch marker

## GAUGE

Cowl: 10 sts = 4" (10.2cm) in garter st with size US 11 needles  
Hat: 12 sts = 4" (10.2cm) in garter st with size 10½ needles

## STITCH GUIDE

### Garter Section:

(6 rounds)

**Rounds 1, 3, and 5:** Purl 1 round.

**Rounds 2, 4, and 6:** Knit 1 round.

### Eyelet Section:

(6 rounds)

**Rounds 1, 3, and 5:** K1, \*(yo, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

**Rounds 2, 4, and 6:** Knit.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Cowl

With size 11 circular needle, loosely cast on 65 sts. Place marker and join in the round, taking care not to twist the sts.

Work 1 Garter section (6 rounds).

Work 1 Eyelet section (6 rounds).

Repeat these 2 sections once more, then end with a garter st section. Bind off loosely with larger needle.

Weave in all ends.

### Hat

With size 10½ circular needle, loosely cast on 57 sts. Place marker and join in the round, taking care not to twist the sts.

Work 1 Garter section (6 rounds).

Work 1 Eyelet section (6 rounds).

Work 4 more rows of Eyelet.

Continue working in Stockinette st until total length is 8" (20.3cm), ending 2 sts before the marker, k2tog. (56 sts)

Begin decreasing as follows, changing to double pointed needles when needed.

**Round 1:** \*(K6, k2tog), repeat from \* around.

**Round 2:** Knit.

**Round 3:** \*(K5, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

**Round 4:** Knit.

**Round 5:** \*(K4, k2tog), repeat from \* around.

**Round 6:** \*(K3, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

**Round 7:** \*(K2, k2tog), repeat from \* around.

**Round 8:** \*(K1, k2tog); repeat from \* around.

**Round 9:** \*(K2tog); repeat from \* around.

Cut yarn and thread through remaining 7 sts.

Pull up tight and anchor.

Weave in all ends.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**k** = knit

**k2tog** = knit two sts together

**st(s)** = stitch(es)

**yo** = yarn over
